

VA BENEFITS & ENTITLEMENTS

Few of our clients are aware that:

1. Both retired vets and their spouses/widows are entitled to benefits provided
 - a. discharge was other than dishonorable
 - b. they are disabled or over age 65;
 - c. they served at least 90 days of active duty with one day during a declared war time without requirement for battlefield service.
 - d. certain family income limits
2. In addition to service connected disability benefits for a veteran, there are pension benefits such as Aid & Attendance (A & A) available to provide care aides (including family members) to homebound, (not-bedridden) vets/spouses/widows, and to assisted living and nursing home residents. These benefits range from \$1,000 - \$1,950 per month to defray those private pay costs before Medicaid qualification.
3. These benefits are in addition to available VA nursing home placement in the three state VA homes in Paramus, Menlo Park and Vineland. The quality of care credentials of these three homes are equal to private nursing facilities.
